Elementary and Middle School Uniform Policy

Students are expected to come in uniform from the first day of school and STAY in uniform throughout the entire school day. Uniforms are there at school to teach students discipline, unity and to let them focus on their studies, besides teaching them how to cover themselves Islamically and modestly.

A one-week window will be granted to new students to adjust to the uniform policy before violations are given.

1st Violation: The office will contact the parents on the same day of the violation to inform them of the violation and for it to be rectified by the next school day.

2nd Violation: The parents will be contacted by the office to bring appropriate uniforms to school. Students will be kept in the office until they are in the correct uniform.

3rd Violation: The parents will be contacted by the office to bring appropriate uniforms to school. Students will be kept in the office until they are in the correct uniform. The student will also receive after-school detention.

Dress Code Policy:

However, if this dress code policy is not followed, then the Middle School Uniform Policy will be enacted for the high school as well.
