Field Trip (4th-E-School)

- What:** *Field trip for fourth grade – e-school to the Baxter Theatre to watch the historical movie, Selma. Students will better understand history and further develop understanding, empathy, compassion, and social justice. Although the Civil Rights Act of 1964 legally desegregated the South, discrimination was still rampant in certain areas, making it very difficult for blacks to register to vote. In 1965, an Alabama city became the battleground in the fight for suffrage. Despite violent opposition, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and his followers pressed forward on an epic march from Selma to Montgomery, and their efforts culminated in President Lyndon Johnson signing the Voting Rights Act of 1965.*

- When:** *Tuesday, February 17, 2015*

**Girls – White, Black, or Navy Blue Hijab required. Girls may only wear a skirt or abaya under the NISL T-Shirt or regular uniform – no pants.*
Students not wearing the NISL T-Shirt nor the uniform will not be permitted on the trip.
- Lunch:** ***Students will have lunch at school, as usual.***
- Prayer:** *Dhuhr prayer will be at school, as usual.*
- Chaperones:** *This event requires prior reservations. Chaperones that book with the Administration by Monday and pay the fee will be allowed to join. After Monday, no chaperones may come.*
Chaperones may not bring children not enrolled at NISL or younger than kindergarten age
Parents serving as chaperones may not separate from the assigned group and/or the school
