Early Childhood Center Schedule of Fees

Early Childhood Center Hours: M-F 7:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m.

Age Group	Full-Time Rate	Daily Rate
Infants	\$150 per week	\$35 per day
Toddlers	\$145 per week	\$35 per day
Two Year Olds	\$130 per week	\$35 per day
Three and Four Year Olds	\$160 per week	\$35 per day
School-Age	\$100 per week	\$35 per day
Before/After School Care (School-Age Only)	\$50 per week or \$7 per hour	

Miscellaneous Fees:

Enrollment Fee:	\$40 (non-refundable)
Late Pickup Fee (after 9 hours)	\$7/hour (rounded up to next hour in one-hour increments)
Bounced Check:	\$35 per check

Tuition Policy:

Early Childhood Center full-time fees must be paid by Friday for the following week for the spot to be reserved.

By the end of the second week, the first week's tuition has to be paid or the child will be withdrawn and not be able to attend the following Monday.

Students in the ECC may take up to two weeks of vacation time per year without paying tuition. If using vacation time, parents must inform the secretary ahead of time and can take up to two weeks of vacation annually without being charged.

Daily option is on a first-come, first-serve basis and is available only if there is an open spot on that day. **Any open spots are given to children enrolling full-time.**

Full-Time: Anytime from 7:00 am to 6:00pm, maximum of nine (9) hours, 5 days a week. **After nine (9) hours, a late pickup fee of \$7 per hour, will be added.**

Daily: Anytime between 7:00am to 6:00pm, any day between Monday through Friday, up to nine (9) hours a day. **After nine (9) hours, a late pickup fee of \$7 per hour, will be added.**

Before/After School Care: From 7:00 am to 7:45 am for the morning session, and from 3:45 to 6:00 pm for the afternoon session **for students enrolled at Nur Islamic School of Louisville.**
