What:

Field Trip for kindergarten – E-School to Oxmoor Farms – Food Literacy Project

Dress:

NISL T-Shirt with Jean, Navy Blue, Black, or Khaki Bottoms OR Uniform
Girls – White, Black, or Navy Blue Hijab required. Skirt, Abaya, or **Loose, Covering pants may be worn. Girls 5th grade and up may only wear a skirt or abaya under the NISL T-Shirt or regular uniform – no pants. * Wear comfortable, waterproof shoes. Rain or winter boots are preferred since it may be muddy. Wear a sweater or light jacket if the weather will be cool.*
Students not wearing the NISL T-Shirt nor the uniform will not be permitted on the trip.
T-Shirts may be purchased from the Main Office.

Lunch:

Students need to bring lunch and snack in a paper bag. Students should also bring a water bottle labeled with their name. No lunch is sold at the farm.

Prayer:

Dhuhr prayer will be held at the masjid upon our return

Chaperones:

Only chaperones with prior approval and payment may accompany and board the bus
Chaperones may not bring children not enrolled at NISL or younger than kindergarten age
Parents serving as chaperones may not separate from the assigned group and/or the school
